HIGH SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS STUDENT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Award Application and Teacher Recommendation forms are designed to gather enough information to judge a student's musical accomplishments, commitment, motivation and dreams.

The submission must include all of the following to be considered:

1. Completed application form (form is attached).
2. A musical submission via a performance link to YouTube, personal website, Vimeo, or a CD which contains three (3) pieces that show your range of ability and represents three different musical periods.
 - Include timing for each piece.
 - Repertoire other than concerto movements is preferred by the achievement awards committee as the winner will be expected to play a recital based on their submission pieces.
 - If a piece requires accompaniment, your submission must be performed with accompaniment. Piano reduction is an acceptable substitute for orchestra accompaniment, but please record each movement on a separate track.
 - If submitting via CD, all recordings must be playable via standard compact disc playback. CDs, CD-Rs and other formats that play back solely through PCs and Macs are not acceptable. Please double check your recordings before submitting them.
 - Finalists will be required to play excerpts from the same three pieces submitted on their recording. There will be no exceptions.
3. Two (2) letters of recommendation from individuals who are in a position to attest to your level of musical achievement. At least one of the letters must come from a current instrument teacher, ensemble teacher or private coach (forms are attached).

Completed applications must be postmarked no later than THURSDAY, MARCH 30, 2018 for consideration. Any materials postmarked or hand delivered later than March 30, 2017 will not be accepted.
