

HMA Reading Orchestra Announces 2022-2023 Season

Harvard Musical Association is pleased to invite returning and new players to participate in orchestral reading sessions led by Music Director Jin Kim. The Orchestra begins its 75th season on **Friday, September 30, 2022**, and convenes in the Marsh Room at the Harvard Musical Association, 57A Chestnut Street, Boston, MA 02108 (Beacon Hill). Covid-19
